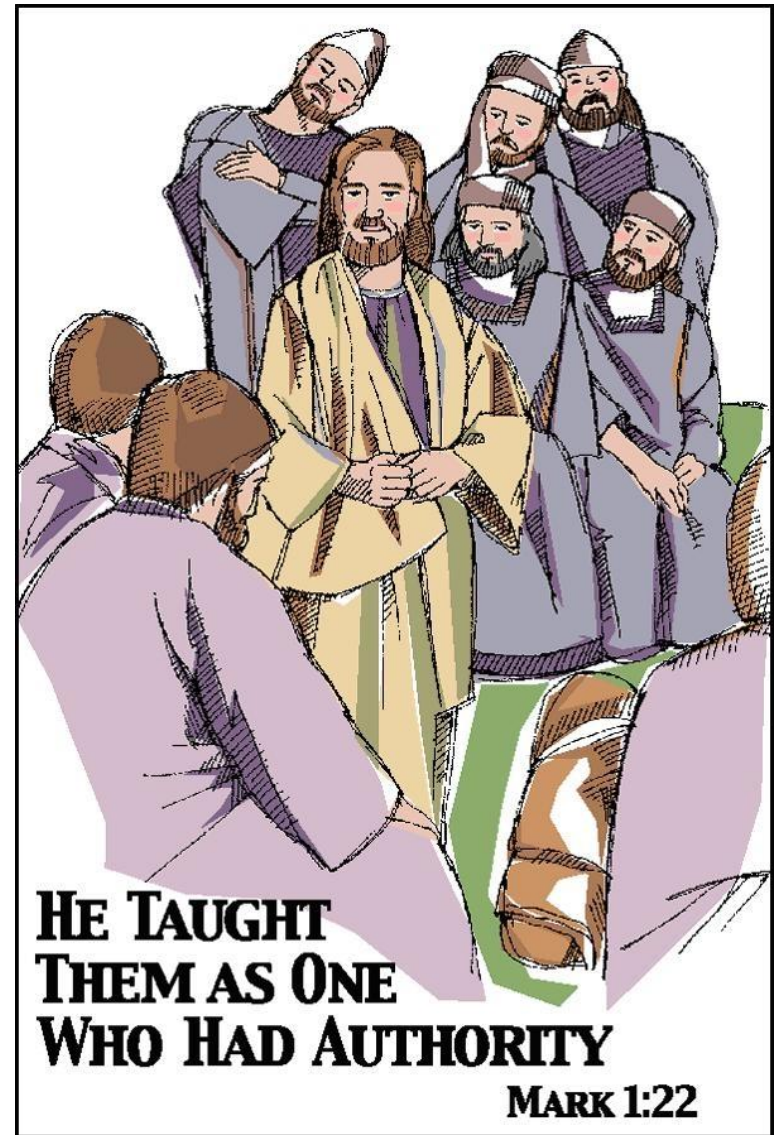

ALTAR FLOWERS FOR 2018 – TIME TO SIGN UP!

The altar flower calendar for 2018 has been posted in the Sunday school hallway. There are quite a few Sundays open to place flowers in the church: February 4, 11, 18, 25; March 4, 11, 18; April 1 (Easter), 22; May 27; June 17, 24; July 8, 29; September 2, 16, 23; October 7, 21, 28; November 4, 11, 18, 25; December 2, 30. There are four dates available to place **one vase**: April 29; July 22; October 14; and December 23. You have the option to have the **silk** flowers placed on the altar and make a donation which will go into the General Fund and you will get “credit” for your donation. **If you choose the silk flower option, please write SILK on the calendar. If you just write “1” or “2” we will presume you want cut flowers and will place order with florist.** Please fill out a “Reservations for Altar Flowers” form and place it in the “completed forms” envelope, offering plate, or call the church office at 717-653-5683. The price of flowers is \$50.00 for 2 vases; \$25.00 for 1 vase (if only one vase has been requested, the price is \$30.00 for 1 vase).
